Note NACFA Rule #5 for Registration: The owner of a lamb(s) bought in dam (ewe purchased as bred) may apply for registration, but is required to submit this completed Certificate of Service form to the Breed Secretary in addition to the registration application to register all resulting lambs. The breeder, in such instance, is defined as the owner of the dam at the time of lambing; and therefore will tattoo their flock letters in the lamb's right ear. Registration names are assigned by the owner of the lambs.
